- To implement, manage, maintain, and continuously improve team standards and team protocols in support of the attached PHAFC Core Values.
- To assist the Senior Coach in all fixtured games in a professional leadership manner.
- To assist the PHAFC in the recruitment of, and retention of, a quality playing list and coaching roster.
- To always represent the PHAFC with the appropriate manner on and off the field.

## **Remuneration**

Appointment will be offered to the selected candidate at an agreed amount.

An annual appraisal of the position shall occur in the two (2) weeks immediately following the conclusion of the respective VAFA season and compliance with this position description shall be considered in detail.
