VFL Assistant Coach / Line Coach

Job Overview

The role of the Williamstown Football Club VFL Assistant Coach is to assist the Senior Coach in all coaching requirements for the Williamstown Football Club in the VFL.

Key Responsibilities

- Assist and support the Senior Coach on game day & at all training sessions.
- Produce and implement Individual Development Plans (IDP) for all area/line players
- Drive skill acquisition of players in alignment with Individual Development Plans and requirements for their roles
- Provide weekly feedback to individual players based on performance as required
- Assist in the preparation and implementation of weekly training plan for squad
- Manage a line (Back/Mid/Fwd) both at training and in match day capacity - ensuring the highest possible coaching standards
- Provide weekly feedback on the line performance as required
- Review weekly footage using Sportcode/Hudl and cut individual edits for players using broadcast and behind the goals vision as required
- Provide coaching mentoring to developing coaches

Leadership & Culture

As Assistant Coach you will also be expected to;

- Drive a strong and disciplined culture with players, coaches and staff which reflects the Williamstown core values
- Provide leadership to the playing group that encourages a supportive team environment
- Encourage & Drive high standards in players, coaches and staff
- Ensure a Positive working relationship with all players, coaches and staff

- Current Working with Children Check – **Mandatory**
- Level 2 AFL Coaching Accreditation – **Mandatory**
- Level 1 First Aid - **Desirable**
- Demonstrated leadership skills and the ability to work in a team environment
- Demonstrated ability to develop and present feedback to players and coaches
- Demonstrated ability to interpret game trends and provide solutions
- Demonstrated ability to work with Sportcode, Keynote and Hudl
- Highly developed verbal and written communication skills

- Work directly with other assistant coaches
- VFL Football Manager
- Work in conjunction with the High Performance team and medical team to ensure players are able to achieve peak performance

- Attend local matches to review VFL listed players (fixtures permitting) as required
